Subject: Financial assistance for procurement of machinery/ equipment/ chemical analysis instruments aimed at enhancing the exploration activities - reg.

Availability of machinery/ equipment / instruments and other latest technological upgradations of the existing equipment/ software etc. are of paramount importance for successful accomplishment of mineral exploration work and expediting the pace of mineral exploration.

2. In order to facilitate strengthening of machinery/ equipment / instruments in facilities of Central Government organizations and State DGMs/DMGs, aimed at enhancing the exploration activities, NMET will consider proposals for providing funds, after evaluation by Technical-cum Cost Committee (TCC) as follows:

- i. Central Government organizations like IBM, GSI etc. will be given fund from NMET as per the requirement for the purpose of procurement of machinery/ equipment/ instruments and other latest technological upgradations of the existing equipment/ software etc.
 - ii. State DGMs/DMGs will be given upto 10% of the total approved exploration project cost including approved project cost of concerned state PSUs, sanctioned in a year for the purpose of procurement of machinery/ equipment/ instruments and other latest technological upgradations of the existing equipment/ software etc.
